TAIWAN VISIT

On Wednesday, October 22, we welcomed a group of 24 school administrators from Taiwan, Republic of China. This partnership with the Taiwan educational system was formed last year when our Roxanne DeWeerd, Superintendent, and Sue Curro, Assistant Superintendent, visited Taiwan with a group of administrators from Michigan. The goal of each visit being to promote international education and appreciation for the culture in both school communities.

The Taiwanese visitors were given a true Georgetown welcome with a welcome song by Ms. VanArkel's class (led by Mrs. Bretz) and display of art work created by our students with the guidance of Mrs. Brouwer, and also received an official welcome in Chinese by Tessa from Mr. Bowen's classrom!

During the visit, Georgetown Elementary was invited to be a "sister school" with Raey Guang Elementary which resides in the city of Pingtung, Taiwan. Principal Chung Wen Yu would like to collaborate (students and staff) over email to learn about one another's education programs and cultures. Some interesting information about our sister school: Raey Guang Elementary School is located in Pingtung, a city in the southern portion of Taiwan. The school is situated in an urban area, and considered to be "medium" sized. There are 36 classes, grades 1-6. A total of 1,200 students attend the school, taught by a faculty of 64. (Comparison to Georgetown....20 classes, grades PK-5, 571 students, 20 Pk-5 teachers.)

SNOW DAY PROCEDURE FOR HOT LUNCH

With snow just around the corner, the food service program would like to remind parents and students about what will happen if school is closed due to weather. If your district is closed, the menu that was supposed to be served on the snow day will be moved to the next school day. An example: if school is canceled on Tuesday due to weather, Tuesday's menu will be served on Wednesday and the menu that was scheduled for Wednesday will be completely canceled. Because of our computer lunch account system, there will be no need to issue credits and your student will still be able to order a lunch if they need one. The only exception to this policy is if school is canceled on Friday. In this case, Friday's menu will be completely canceled and we will continue with the regular menu on Monday.
