***Special Instructions:** Art can be messy, please be sure that your child wears *old* play clothes for class.

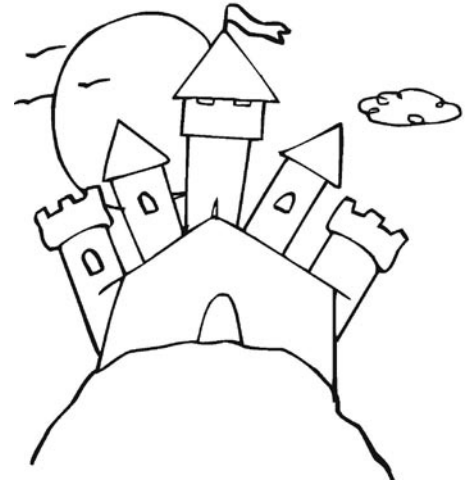
