## GREAT START READINESS PROGRAM (GSRP) ~ 2009/2010 FOUR YEAR OLD PRESCHOOL

GSRP is a state-funded preschool program for Hudsonville four year olds who exhibit two factors from the state's list of eligibility criteria (below). This program allows children who qualify an opportunity to receive a high-quality preschool experience who may not otherwise have the chance.

### Eligibility criteria

- low birth weight (under 5 lbs. 8 oz.)
- developmentally immature
- physical and/or sexual abuse and neglect
- nutritionally deficient
- long-term or chronic illness
- diagnosed handicapping condition
- lack of a stable support system of residence
- destructive or violent temperament
- substance abuse or addiction
- language deficiency or immaturity
- non-English/limited English speaking household
- incarcerated parent
- family history of low school achievement or dropout
- family history of delinquency
- family history of diagnosed family problems
- low parent/sibling educational attainment or illiteracy
- single parent
- unemployed parent(s)
- low family income
- family density
- parental/sibling loss by death or parental loss by divorce
- teenage parent
- chronically ill parent/sibling
- housing in rural or segregated area

\* Documentation of factors is kept confidential and secure on file at preschool site.

Site: South Elementary  
Sessions: Monday through Thursday, 9:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. - OR -  
Monday through Thursday, 12:30 p.m. - 3:00 p.m.  
Tuition: Free to qualifying families

\* Immunization records and copy of certified birth certificate needed for all students prior to start of school year.
