While we paint to our hearts' content!

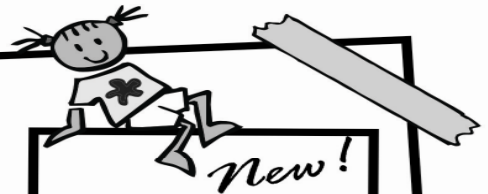
