- ❑ SCHEDULE with Secretaries


PLACEMENT INTO PK OR K

- ❑ Pre-kindergarten placement requests honored based on availability.
- ❑ Preference To birth dates between September 1 - December 1.
- ❑ Parents will be notified of placement decisions by May 31, 2019.
